

Mid-Winter IBT Meeting Sarasota, FL Jan 8-12, 2018

Although I have attended WBAC Int'l Board of Trustee meetings held at our International Rallies, this was my first Mid-Winter meeting and my first IBT since becoming our Region 2 Vice President. With about 85 rigs on site and another 15 or so attendees who, like me, travelled without their Airstreams the Mid-Winter is mostly about doing the business of the WBAC. I was pleased to join our President and First Lady, Mark and Debbie Hammer, at the scheduled workshops, roundtable discussions, and IBT meetings. Here are some items of interest from the meetings:

- WBAC is averaging about 30 new members a WEEK.
- 259 of the 751 who have registered for Salem, OR are First Timers.

• Int'l Rally arrival registration will now be called "check-in", attendees will receive packet of info when parking and a ticket to later claim their rally "goody bag/gift".

• The Salem, OR International Rally Schedule will be released in February 2018.

• There are now 17 National caravans (14 are full) scheduled for 2018 vs.10 in 2017 with 3 new caravans and several "resurrected" ones with new leaders. Great news!

• Caravan Leader Training has been successful and is being reworked into a shorter, digital format to provide the capability for presentation at rallies and locations around the country. More Training + Qualified Leaders = More Caravans

• 740 w/e sites plus a number of solar/gen sites will be available in Doswell, VA for the 2019 International Rally scheduled for July 20-27, 2019. Sign up (electronically) ASAP when registration opens during the Salem rally!

• The 2019 Mid-Winter IBT will be held January 14-18, 2019 at the Baldwin County Coliseum in Robertsdale, AL.

• There are still Units not in compliance with updated Constitution and ByLaws (currently 4 in Region 2). All have been notified and a working deadline of May 1 has been set. Those out of compliance after that date risk endangering their status in WBCCI. A motion was approved to make some changes to the Model CBL to better reflect the actual practices of individual Units.

• The Electronic Communications Committee has reviewed all existing Unit and Region websites and a guideline list of essential elements was prepared and sent to those Units needing to upgrade or develop new websites. Assistance is available from the ECC.

• The ECC reported 363 online registrations for Salem vs 217 for Escanaba vs 132 for the Lewisburg Rally. Proof of continued growth and use of online services by members.

• Approximately 20 Unit name changes (incorporating "Airstream" in the name), 6 Unit flags/logos and 3 Unit badges were approved.
